To ask the Minister for Health the number of vaccines supplied to CHO West; the breakdown of these numbers supplied to counties Mayo, Galway and Roscommon; the number of personnel who have received their first shot of vaccine within the primary care, mental health and well-being settings; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Dillon,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The total number of vaccines supplied to CHO West is 4102 and the breakdown is as follows:

- Galway - 2214
- Mayo - 1338
- Roscommon – 550

The number of staff vaccinated by the Community Vaccination Team up to 20/01/2021 is 2418.
