PQ 4030/21 (101) To ask the Minister for Health the way and location in which providers of homecare services can register for the vaccination of homecare workers on the Covid-19 vaccination list.

Dear Deputy Murphy,

Now that there is a safe and effective vaccine available, we are aware that most people are keen to get vaccinated as quickly as possible. Currently the key constraint is that there is only a limited amount of vaccine available so it is not possible to reach everyone as quickly as we would like. Given that limitation the Government published a national list of Provisional Vaccine Allocation Groups on December 8<sup>th</sup>. The roll out of the vaccine programme has been to the first two priority groups. Frontline healthcare workers who are employed as careers are in group 2 and will be informed through their line management as soon as additional supply is received.
