16 Top Tips for Patient Safety

- 1 Engage patients as partners in their care
- Involve patients in the design, planning and delivery of our health service
- Communicate clearly with patients about their care
- Introduce yourself to patients and their family
- 5 Mind your personal health and wellbeing
- 6 Look out for colleagues who need support
- Improve the culture of your workplace by practising Values in Action
- 8 Speak up if you see something unsafe
- Greate a secure environment for people to discuss their concerns

- Recognise, highlight and build on existing good patient safety practice
- Improve the quality and timeliness of incident reviews
- Implement a learning culture to improve patient safety
- Clean your hands properly to reduce risk of infection
- Know about the common harms that happen in your clinical workplace
