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## IMPORTANT NEWS Re: Primary Childhood Immunisation Schedule

4th August 2017

**Dear Doctor** 

I am writing to update you about the Primary Childhood Immunisation Schedule introduced in 2016.

As part of the 2016 changes, all babies born on or after October 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 will receive a combined Haemophilus influenza type b/Meningococcal group C (Hib/MenC) vaccine at 13 months. This combined vaccine Menitorix (GSK) will replace the current individual Men C and Hib vaccines given at 13 months.

Babies born before 1 October 2016 should remain on the old schedule and receive separate Hib and MenC vaccines at 13 months, Hiberix and Menjugate, regardless of when they present for vaccination.
